

**RESOLUTION No. 08/09-46**  
**CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON**

*A Resolution Amending the City's Public Contracting Rules to Allow for Personal Service Contract Renewals*

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to amend its Public Contracting Rules to allow for the renewal of certain personal service contracts at the City Council's discretion; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Public Contracting Code codified in ORS chapters 279A, 279B, and 279C and the Attorney General Model Rules under OAR 137, divisions 46, 47, 48, and 49 allow local governments to adopt contracting rules different from or in addition to those in the Model Rules so long as they are consistent with the Code.

**WHEREAS**, the City passed Resolution No 04/05-29 adopting Public Contracting Rules.

**The City of Dayton resolves as follows:**

**Section 1:** The City of Dayton hereby amends Section 1.10.020 of the Public Contracting Rules to read:

(7) The City Council, at its discretion, may renew a personal service contract for up to a maximum of one year if the personal service contract does not contain renewal terms.

**Section 2:** This resolution will be effective immediately upon adoption by the City Council.


