

**RESOLUTION #09/10-11
CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON**

Title: *A Resolution Relating to Employees' Required PERS Contribution of 6% of Salary*

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton, tax ID number 93-6002149, is a member of the Public Employees Retirement System (hereinafter "PERS) with member number 02252; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to "pick-up" the employee share for those eligible employees contributing the required 6% of salary as permitted under Internal Revenue Code Section 414(h)(2);

WHEREAS, ORS 238.205(6) requires PERS to maintain written notice of the City's employee contributions;

The City of Dayton resolves as follows:

- 1) **THAT** the required PERS contribution of 6% of salary is deemed to be "picked up" for purposes of Internal Revenue Code Section 414(h)(2); and
- 2) **THAT** employees do not have the option of receiving the salary payment and paying the PERS employee contribution directly; and
- 3) **THAT** this resolution repeals Resolution 95/96-05, adopted December 4th, 1995; and
- 4) **THAT** this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




