

**RESOLUTION #09/10-17  
CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON**

**Title:** *A Resolution Awarding the Electrical Wiring for Lift Stations to DND Industrial Control*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dayton experiences periods of power outages requiring emergency generation to operate our sewer lift stations; and

**WHEREAS**, transfer switches and generator receptacles are needed for the ongoing operation of our sewer lift stations during outage periods; and

**WHEREAS**, funds for this project have been budgeted in the 2009/2010 City of Dayton Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, competitive quotes were received for said work as summarized in Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, DND Industrial Control submitted the lowest responsible quote for a total of \$7,894.15 for electrical improvements at the 9<sup>th</sup> Street Pump Station, the Footbridge Pump Station and the Hwy 221 Pump Station;

**The City of Dayton resolves as follows:**

- 1) **THAT** the City Council hereby awards the installation of electrical improvements at the 9<sup>th</sup> Street Pump Station, the Footbridge Pump Station and the Hwy 221 Pump Station ; and
- 2) **THAT** the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with DND Industrial Control for completion of the contract work; and
- 3) **THAT** this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




