- 2) **THAT** this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.





One Year Council Goals

Administration

- Partner with Dayton Community Development Association in support of activities to promote businesses and activities in our community
- Complete Phase I improvements to the Community Center
- Explore adoption of hotel/motel or transient lodging tax
- Complete SDC methodology/analysis
- Support historic preservation
- Continue enhancement of the City's website
- Develop criteria for donations to the community from the Revenue Sharing Fund

Parks

- Replace the roofing and deteriorated siding on the Blockhouse
- Complete the interior pathway improvements within Courthouse Square Park
- Create an informational kiosk and/or historic walking tour kiosk within Courthouse Square Park
- Work with the National Guard in rehabilitating the cannon in Courthouse Square Park
- Identify appropriate placement of the imitation rock play feature
- Complete the Veteran's Memorial in cooperation with the VFW in Courthouse Square Park
- Reroof picnic shelter using volunteer services
- Work with the School District to find solutions to recondition Legion Field

Library

- Continue improvements of the book inventory
- Surplus old book inventory
- Increase circulation through improved community outreach
- Increase attendance in summer reading program

Planning

- Evaluate the planning fee structure
- Complete update to Dayton Land Use and Planning Codes
- Continue cooperation with Historic Preservation Committee
- Update Land Use applications

Public Safety/Court Operations

- Continue to provide police services to the community
- Continue court operations
- Review Dayton Municipal Code for appropriate revisions
- Administer bicycle/helmet safety program

Public Works

- Complete the Water System Master Plan
- Complete the Wastewater Facilities Plan
- Complete the sidewalks on the west side of 3rd Street from Mill to Ferry.
- Seek additional funding options for continuation of sidewalks
- Implement Water Conservation efforts
- Identify funding sources for rehabilitation of Springs System or alternative water source
- Identify means to excavate bio-solids from lagoon system to increase capacity.
- Identify methods to reduce I/I (Infiltration and Inflow)
- Fence Well #5
