WHEREAS, another requirement to receive these funds is that the City must enact a resolution each year stating that they wish to receive them;

1. **THAT** pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City of Dayton hereby elects to receive state revenues for fiscal year 2009/2010
2. **THAT** this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.



Please use the address on this ordinance to return the form back to me. By not using the correct address, the ordinance could be delayed for up to four weeks and this will mean that you will not receive State Revenue Sharing payments.
