RESOLUTION # 09/10-21

TITLE: A Resolution Authorizing the Municipal Court to Establish and Revise Traffic School Program Fees; Establish and Revise Fix-it Ticket Program Fees and Consolidate and Revise Municipal Court City Assessment Fees.

WHEREAS, the Dayton Municipal Court was established by the City Council and has jurisdiction to adjudicate all State Motor Vehicle Code violations which occur within the city limits of Dayton, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to revise the existing fee structures and establish new fees for the Traffic School Program and the Fix-It Ticket Program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to revise and consolidate Municipal Court City Assessment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton as the legislative body for the City, may adopt enactments that establish authority for the Municipal Court.

The City of Dayton resolves as follows:

- 1. **THAT** the Dayton City Council authorizes revisions to the Traffic School Program and Fix-It Ticket Program as provided for in the General Order which is attached as Exhibit "A" and authorizes the revisions of City Court fees and the consolidation of Municipal Court City Assessments as set forth by the Municipal Court and provided for in Exhibit "A".
- 2. THAT, the Dayton City Council makes the following findings:
 - a. The Council finds that in order to adequately conduct the public safety program of enforcement of traffic laws throughout the City for the protection of citizens and motorists passing through the City, the City is in need of proper equipment, training and other necessary resources to operate the Court.
 - b. The City finds new fees and the revision and consolidation of existing fees and assessments are necessary to effectuate the City's goals.
 - c. The Court is authorized to establish and levy the fees and assessments through a General Order of the Court.
 - d. The Court is directed to amend the Uniform Minimum Fine Schedule to include the above fine revisions and assessments; and
- 3. **THAT** the proposed General Order of the Court is attached as Exhibit "A" for the City Council's reference. The City Council expresses its approval of the General Order and the Municipal Judge has full authority to adopt, amend and enforce General Orders of the Court; and

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4. THAT this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

GENERAL ORDER

RECITALS

- 1. The Dayton Municipal Court has been granted jurisdiction to adjudicate all State Motor Vehicle Code violations which occur within the city limits of Dayton, Oregon.
- 2. The Court established a Traffic School program through General Order No. 2007-001 and desires to revise the existing fees and establish a fee for 55 Alive program.
- 3. The Court established a Fix-It Ticket Program through General Order No. 2007-002 and desires to revise the existing fees and establish a fee for Administrative Matters.
- 4. The Court desires to consolidate and revise the fee for City Assessments ordered by the Court.
- 5. The Dayton City Council has adopted Resolution No. 09/10-21 approving revisions to the Municipal Court Fees.

IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. General Order No. 2007-001 Section 3 is updated to reflect an increase in fees to the court for administration of the Traffic School program (including Municipal Court assessments) as follows: \$90.00 for Class "D" violation; \$125 for a Class "C" violation.
- 2. The court also establishes a fee for the Traffic School program at \$100 for 55 Alive program.
- 3. General Order No. 2007-002 Section 4 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language "There is a Fix-It Ticket Program Equipment Citation of \$75.00 and an Administrative Citation of \$150."
- 4. The three (3) existing City Assessments are consolidated into one (1) City Assessment totaling \$20.
- 5. Attached as an exhibit is the schedule and proposed fee changes, which by this reference are part of the order.
