## RESOLUTION #09/10-22 CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON

Title: A Resolution Supporting the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments Filing an Application on Behalf of the City of Dayton for a Technical Assistance Grant to Provide Amendments to the City's Land Use and Development Code

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton currently has a Land Use and Development Code to guide residential, commercial and industrial development within the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton while experiencing an interest in revitalizing its downtown realizes that its Code needs revisions to better facilitate the approval of business activities within the central city while balancing other development needs within the community and understanding the need to maintain emphasis on preserving and protecting the many historic resources within the community; and

- THAT the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Land Conservation and Development Department (DLCD) Technical Assistance (TA) program for grant funds to support the revisions to the Dayton Land Use and Development Code and to make any applicable changes to the other regulating documents for the City of Dayton, and
- 2) **THAT** this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
