

**RESOLUTION #11/12-2
CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON**

Title: *A Resolution Establishing Fees for Notarial Acts*

WHEREAS, under ORS 194.164 a public body may collect fees for notarial acts performed in the course of employment by notaries public who are employed by the public body for the purposes of defraying costs incurred by the public body for providing notarial services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton wishes to establish fees for the performance of notarial acts for the public; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton held a public hearing on Tuesday, July 5, 2011 to receive comment on the proposed fees;

The City of Dayton resolves as follows:

- 1) **THAT** there shall be no charge for performing a notarial act for those who provide satisfactory evidence of residency within the City Limits of Dayton as determined by the City of Dayton staff; and
- 2) **THAT** the fee for providing notary services to those who reside outside of the City Limits of the City of Dayton shall be \$10 per notarial act.
- 3) **THAT** this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


