Title: *A Resolution Awarding the Contract for the 9th Street Sewer Pump Station Overflow Modifications*

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton owns and maintains a lift station on 9th Street to handle the wastewater flow from the residences in the area; and

WHEREAS, the pump station is in need of repair to improve performance and prevent overflow onto private property; and

WHEREAS, funds for this project are available in the 2011/2012 City of Dayton Budget; and

WHEREAS, competitive quotes were received for said work as summarized in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, The Saunders Company Inc. submitted the lowest responsible bid in the sum of \$22,609 for said work;

The City of Dayton resolves as follows:

- 1) **THAT** the City Council hereby awards the contract for the 9th Street Sewer Pump Station Overflow Modifications to The Saunders Company Inc. in the sum of \$22,609; and
- 2) **THAT** the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with The Saunders Company Inc. for completion of the work; and
- 3) **THAT** this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
