#### 2012/13 Council Goals

### Administration

- Continue to incorporate a sense of community through the establishment of relationships with the Dayton Community Development Association (DCDA), Dayton Together Coalition, Veteran's of Foreign Wars Post #10626, Dayton School District, Dayton Fire District and others
- Research and support opportunities to promote businesses and activities in our community
- Consider a formal review of the SDC methodology/analysis for water/wastewater/street/storm/and parks
- Develop ideas for generating revenue sources for the continuation of City services
- Create a budget that ensures efficient and accountable governmental services to the community

#### **Parks**

- Complete the interior pathway improvements within Courthouse Square Park
- Create an informational kiosk and/or historic walking tour kiosk within Courthouse Square Park
- Reroof picnic shelter using volunteer services
- Rehabilitation of Miller Fountain within Courthouse Square Park
- Address cannon placement within Courthouse Square Park
- Work with the School District to find solutions to recondition Legion Field
- Install play equipment in 11<sup>th</sup> Street Park
- Identify funding for improvements to Alderman Park for use as a dog park
- Address clean-up, maintenance and rehabilitation of Palmer Creek Trail in Partnership with School District and neighboring property owners

### **Building**

- Address any changes in State Standards associated with codes and permit charges
- Continue public education regarding permit issuance
- Update recordkeeping for permit issuance
- Prepare all permit records for electronic filing
- Create packet of information for distribution to new business owners and developers

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### Library

- Replace computers within the Library
- Reconfigure Library to increase space for collections that have outgrown their allotted space while reducing shelf space for collections not as well utilized
- Continue to offer summer reading program. Seek assistance from college intern for improved organization and programming
- Catalog existing book inventory

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# **Planning**

- Continue to pursue updates to Dayton Land Use and Planning Codes
- Implement Sign Code revisions
- Continue work with Historic Preservation Committee
- Complete requirements associated with Certified Local Government Grant
- Partner in the recognition of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the dedication of the Blockhouse in Dayton
- Identify potential land for industrial use designation which will be eliminated with the construction of the Bypass project
- Identify funding for rehabilitation of Miller Fountain within Courthouse Square Park
- Seek grant funding for additional updates to the Land Use Code

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### Public Safety/Court Operations

- Continue to provide police services to the community
- Propose Operating Levy for police services beyond FY 12/13
- Continue court operations
- Continue review of Dayton Municipal Code for appropriate revisions
- Continue Municipal Code Education Program
- Promote Bicycle Safety Program
- Enhance patrols to limit exposure to vandalism and graffiti

### Public Works

- Seek additional funding options for continuation of sidewalks in the downtown, on the north side of Ferry from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to the cross walk at the grade school, along Fletcher Road from Ash Street to Howard Jordan Loop, and on the north side of Ferry Street from Center Market to the Mobile Home Park
- Work with DCDA on heritage signage and audio tour within Courthouse Square Park
- Partner with VFW Post #10626 for completion of Veteran's Memorial
- Seek mechanisms to improve operations and maintenance
- Conduct survey of capacity of sewer lagoons
- Identify funding sources for lift station improvements
- Clean and inspect water reservoirs
- Begin Springs Rehabilitation
- Complete Springs Negotiation for Extension of Lease and Potential Land Acquisition
- Complete street improvements on 4<sup>th</sup> Street
- Complete exterior painting and signage of Public Works Annex
- Complete intertie with McMinnville Water and Light
- Complete Chapter 190 Agreement for future water management
- Complete landscaping at the Community Center
- Coordinate installation of street signage directing traffic to the Community Center
