- 2) **THAT** this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.





STRATEGIC PLAN GOALS
January 2012

Goal #1 *Develop a proactive plan to handle growth*

- Continue to pursue long-term water supply
 - Complete Comprehensive Review and Update of Development Code
 - Plan for additional City services to accommodate growth
- Review Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) & develop System Development Charges (SDC) standards & methodology
- Seek funding opportunities to expand and develop City buildings

Goal #2 *Create an aesthetically pleasing community*

- Apply for grants for downtown improvements
 - Improve sidewalk conditions within the City
 - Work with ODOT and City Engineer on 5th and Ferry
- Work in cooperation with Dayton Community Development Association (DCDA) on proposed improvements to the business district.

Goal #3 *Create community programs and facilities to support children and families*

- Continue cooperative atmosphere of school, fire district and city to maximize use of public resources and facilities
- Continue Quarterly School, Fire District, City information sharing meetings
- Work with citizens, agencies and organizations in the community to create a volunteer pool for civic activities
- Dayton Coalition for Drug Free Community

Goal #4 *Create a viable business district*

- Review codes that affect downtown core area and Ferry & 3rd Streets
- Budget for & create a Visitor Center
- Work with Dayton Community Development Association (DCDA) in creating opportunities to partner with the business community

Goal #5 *Encourage the preservation of our historic resources*

- Obtain and/or budget funds to preserve Courthouse Square Park

Goal #6 *Actively participate in regional transportation projects*

- Serve on Committees
- Lobbying as necessary for funding or continuation of the project
