

**RESOLUTION NO. 12/13-11
CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON**

Title: *A Resolution Awarding a Contract for Water Line Repair and Replacement*

WHEREAS, the City's water distribution system is critical in providing both reliable and safe drinking water to the residents of Dayton; and

WHEREAS, funds were allocated in the 2012-13 budget for well and system improvements; and

WHEREAS, the water line serving the homes from Palmer Lane to Thompson Lane is in need of repairs and replacement; and

WHEREAS, City Staff used the intermediate procurement process whereby the City obtained three informally solicited competitive price quotes from prospective contractors as summarized in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Raugust Trucking & Excavating, Inc. submitted the low bid for completion of this work in the sum of \$19,950;

The City of Dayton resolves as follows:

- 1) **THAT** the City Council hereby awards the contract for water line repair and replacement from Palmer Lane to Thompson Lane to Raugust Trucking & Excavating, Inc. in the sum of \$19,950; and
- 2) **THAT** the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Raugust Trucking & Excavating, Inc. for completion of the work; and
- 3) **THAT** this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




