A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DAYTON ADJUSTING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 TO ACKNOWLEDGE AWARD OF UNANTICIPATED GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FORD FAMILY FOUNDATION THROUGH THE MID-WILLAMETTE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR DAYTON'S MAIN STREET PROGRAM AND TO EXPEND THE FUNDS TO THE DAYTON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Dayton City Council adopted the 2020-21 budget on June 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the CITY received notification on July 2, 2020, from the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments regarding Ford Family Foundation grant funds being allocated to all member cities; and

WHEREAS, the CITY received \$1,180 on July 6, 2020, to help support our Oregon Main Street program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton's Main Street Program is managed by the Dayton Community Development Association; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Budget Law ORS 294.338(2) allows municipalities to spend unanticipated grant money when it is for a specific purpose and approved by the local governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Dayton City Council will authorize the expenditure of funds not to exceed \$1,180 for work to be determined by the Dayton Community Development Association.

Therefore, the City of Dayton resolves as follows:

1) THAT the following appropriations be made:

General Fund Revenue – Ford Family Grant +\$1,180

Total General Fund Revenue \$743,163

General Fund - Admin Expenditures - Materials & Services - Misc Expense +\$1,180

Total Admin Material and Services \$69,340

Total General Fund Expenditures \$743,163
