

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-19-6
CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON**

Title: *A Resolution Authorizing the City of Dayton to Apply for the Safe Routes to School Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation to fund the 9th Street to Flower Sidewalk Improvement Project and Authorizing the Interim City Manager to Sign the Application*

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is accepting applications for Safe Routes to School grants; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means to fund the 9th Street Flower Sidewalk Improvement project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton’s Transportation System Plan states “the highest priority for sidewalk improvements and maintenance should be on the arterial and collector streets, especially those sidewalks in proximity to the schools”; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application show the grant funds be awarded; and

The City of Dayton resolves as follows:

- 1) **THAT** the City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application to ODOT to fund the 9th to Flower Sidewalk Improvement project; and
- 2) **THAT** this resolution shall be effective following its adoption by the Dayton City Council.
