ORDINANCE No. 599 CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON

An Ordinance Adopting a Declaration of Candidacy Filing Fee and Declaring an Emergency

WHEREAS, the Dayton Municipal Code Section 1.02.02 states that an eligible elector may become a candidate for an elective City position by filing a declaration of candidacy which must be accompanied by a filing fee established by Council Resolution; and

WHEREAS, ORS 221.180(3) states that candidates for any office of a city must file in the manner provided by city charter or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton has not adopted a declaration of candidacy fee through its City Charter or by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Dayton City Council desires, consistent with state statutes, to adopt a fee for eligible voters who wish to become a candidate for an elective City position by filing a declaration of candidacy.

The City of Dayton ordains as follows:

Section 1: The City of Dayton adopts a ten dollar (\$10) fee for those eligible voters who wish to become a candidate for an elective City position by filing a declaration of candidacy.

Section 2: In order to allow eligible voters to file a declaration of candidacy with the appropriate fee, there is an immediate need to enact the foregoing provisions and therefore an emergency is declared. This Ordinance takes effect on the date of passage.
