

RESOLUTION NO. 2025/26-14
CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON

A Resolution Authorizing the City of Dayton to apply for a Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department of the Rehabilitation of Alderman Dog Park and delegating authority to the Tourism and Economic Development Director to sign the application.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Alderman Dog Park Accessibility Project desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the Dayton City Council have identified ADA compliant transitions, paved parking, and park perimeter improvements at Alderman Park as a high priority need in the City of Dayton; and

WHEREAS, the objective of this project is to enhance safety, accessibility, and visitor experience at Alderman Dog Park through the installation of durable, low-maintenance surfaces in key use areas. Improvements will include grading, gravel underlayment, and asphalt paving, resulting in ADA-compliant access and significantly improved usability during all weather conditions.

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Dayton resolves as follows:

Section 1: The Dayton City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for rehabilitation at Alderman Dog Park.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective immediately following its adoption by the Dayton City Council.
